Homestead Certificate No. 1112

APPLICATION 1600

Whereas

There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Sioux Falls, Dakota Territory, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Olef Singberg, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the West half of the North West quarter, and the West half of the South West quarter of Section twenty in Township Twentyfour, of Range Fifty one, in the District of lands subject to sale at Sioux Falls, Dakota Territory containing One Hundred and Sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Olef Singberg, the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Olef Singberg and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, J. Wilson Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
